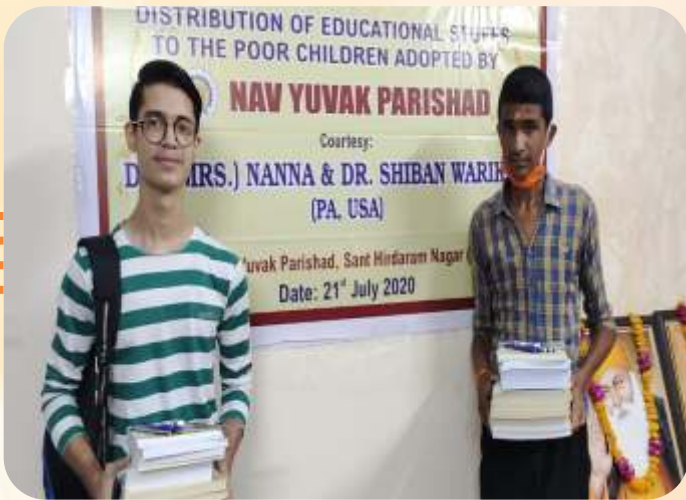

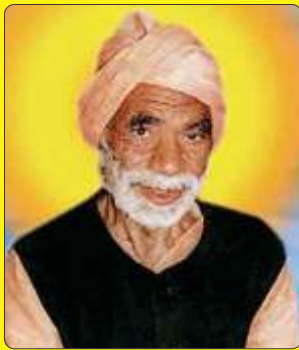

LIFE SAVING GESTURE - SUCCESSFUL BMT SURGERY OF MS. KASHISH GUNWANI (12 YEARS)

“Since last many years, my daughter has been undergoing blood transfusion every fortnight. Whenever I took her for blood transfusion, she starts weeping. It always broke my heart to see such anger & sadness in her eyes, but what else can I do?” said Mrs. Deepa Gunwani, mother of Kashish Gunwani who was diagnosed with Thalassemia Major when she was 3 months old.

Thalassemia Major is an inherited blood disorder in which the body makes an abnormal form of haemoglobin. Haemoglobin is the protein molecule in the red blood cells that carries oxygen. The disease leads to poor growth, impaired physical activities, facial deformities, fragile bones and enlargement of liver & spleen.

Bone Marrow Transplantation (BMT) was the only solution suggested by the doctors for saving Kashish from a lifetime of painful blood transfusions. Now the question was to find stem cells donor either within the family or someone from outside. Unfortunately, the HLA blood tests of siblings & parents did not match with Kashish. Ultimately, the option left was to search an outsider donor which was well arranged by a registered & licensed organisation of Chennai- DATRI Blood Stem Cell Donors Registry in January'2020.

Considering the plight of this little ailing girl, Dr. Rahul Bhargava of 'Fortis Memorial Research Institute, Gurugram' took up the challenge to perform Bone Marrow Transplantation (BMT) Surgery. Now the only concern for the parents was to arrange for heavy cost of treatment i.e., Rs. 15.00 Lacs which included payment to stem-cell donor, chemotherapy, pathological tests, Medicines, hospitalisation, BMT surgery & post-operative care etc.

Kashish lives alongwith her parents and two siblings who are students. Her mother is a housewife & father is the sole earning member in the family. He is a salesman getting meager salary not sufficient to manage even two square meal. The parents just prayed to the Almighty to come to their rescue & save their beloved child from trap of this dreadful disease as it was really impossible for them to arrange such a huge amount. Hence, they approached Jeev Sewa Sansthan(JSS) for help.

Looking to the deteriorating health condition of Kashish, we requested our philanthropists who extended their helping hands open heartedly & we were able to collect the original budgeted amount.

Due to Covid-19 situation, the hospital management submitted enhanced package of Rs. 20.00 Lacs which was not very easy for us to arrange. Hence, we approached 'Have a Heart Foundation, Bengaluru' who further contacted representatives of 'Milaap' for amplifying the fund raising campaign through crowd funding. So the campaign is still on for the balance amount of Rs. 5.00 Lacs towards post-operative expenses.

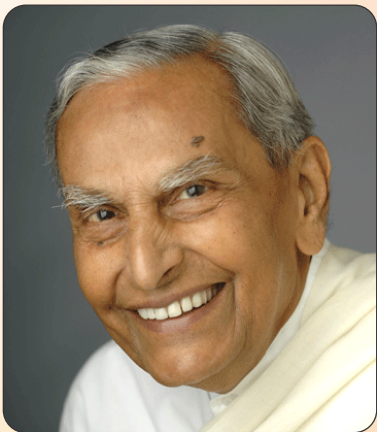

This is absolutely true. At cellular level all human beings are identical physiologically, biologically anatomically, histologically and spiritually.

Each man devoted to his own duty attains highest perfection leading to liberation. 18-45

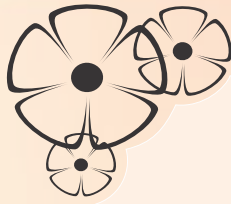

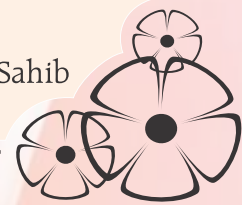
