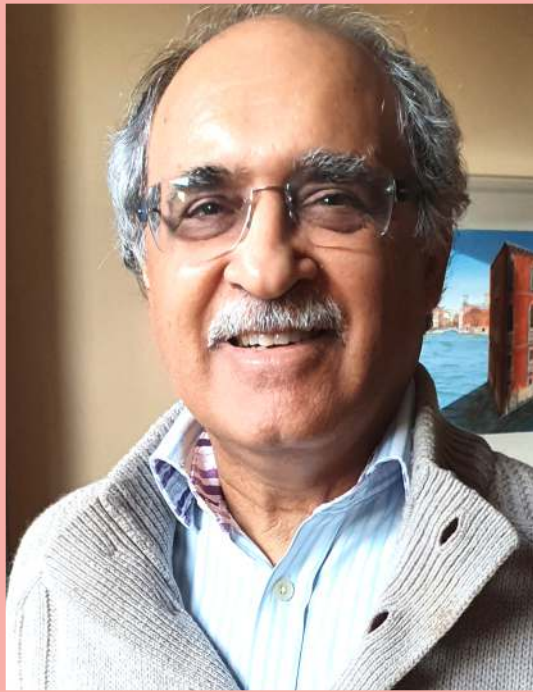

● SHRI JIWANLAL VALIRAM THAKUR DARGANI (PHILIPPINES) ● - A LEGEND WITH PHILANTHROPIC APPROACH

We feel proud and privileged to be associated with 96 years old living legend, patriotic leader, freedom fighter & renowned philanthropist of Philippines-Resp. Dada Jiwanlal Valiram Dargani. He was a member of Indian National Army (INA) headed by great Indian Freedom Fighter, Netaji Subash Chandra Bose. His life journey which started from Nasarpur, Sindh to Manila, Philippines is full of challenges, struggles & triumphs.

Dada Jiwanlal V. Dargani lost his father, Shri Valiram T. Dargani at the tender age of 10 years. He has 4 brothers & 1 sister. He completed his primary education in Nasarpur, Sindh and secondary education in Karachi. He was 15 years old when war broke out in Europe and India being a British colony was much affected.

In 1940, his maternal uncle brought him to Manila where he attended school in the morning & worked as a salesman in the afternoon. In 1941, Second World War broke out in Southeast Asia in which Japanese Imperial Army occupied Philippines and arrested 12 Indian Nationals including Dada Jiwanlal Dargani. On releasing from prison, he travelled to Manila.

In 1943, Dada Jiwanlal Dargani was filled with patriotism after listening to the inspiring speech of freedom fighter, Netaji Subash Chandra Bose on radio. Netaji needed volunteers for the Indian National Army (INA). Dada Jiwanlal was chosen for Officers' Training in

Neeson, Singapore where he learned the importance of bravery, cooperation, team spirit, discipline & respect for others. In 1944, he was offered the rank of 2nd Lieutenant at Officer Training School where he served for 14 months. He was imprisoned from August'1945 till March'1946. After sudden demise of Netaji Subash Chandra Bose in plane crash, all were free to leave. Dada Jiwanlal stayed in the camp until he received a job offer in Singapore.

In August'1946, Dada Jiwanlal came back to Manila where he bought American goods & sold it in Singapore. He returned back to India in July'1947.

On 15th August'1947, riots broke all over Sindh which was to become part of Pakistan. Amidst all uncertainty & political turmoil, Dada Jiwanlal married with Vidya (Asudi Aurani) at Tando Adam, Sindh. Soon after, they had to flee Sindh as refugees by train & settled in Ajmer, Rajasthan. In 1949, Dada returned back to Manila & started his business in optical goods. He has 5 children & 9 Grandchildren.

Dada Jiwanlal has loyalty towards his motherland India – that gave him life & The Philippines that nurtured him through the years.

Salutation to Dada Jiwanlal V. Dargani for his hard work, perseverance, philanthropic gesture & above all spirit of patriotism. His success story will surely inspire young countrymen to walk on the righteous path of patriotism & humanity.

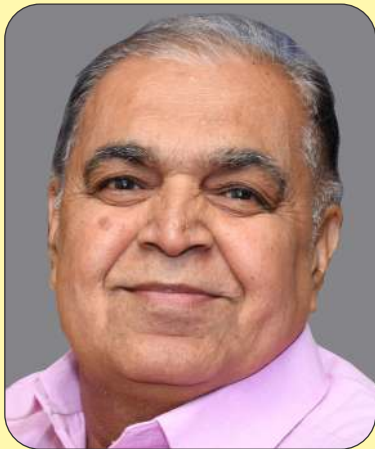

When the stock market index goes up and up, people feel jubilant but when it nose dives, some people commit suicide! The same index brings happiness for some and misery for others.

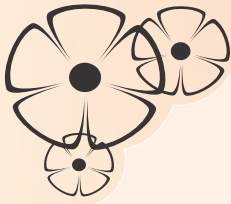

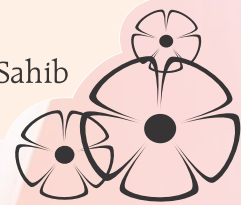
