


MESSAGE FROM MR. DAYAL N HARJANI, CHAIRMAN (ERASE POVERTY, HONG KONG)



LIFE SAVING GESTURES IN 92ND FREE UROLOGY CAMP ••••

SUCCESSFUL BLADDER SURGERY (70mm STONE) OF MR. HUKUM SINGH



Due to lack of appropriate medical facilities in the village and shortage of funds, Mr. Hukum Singh, a farm laborer, just 29 years old, residing in Tarawali village of Raisen District, 50 kms away from Bhopal, was not able to get surgery done for removing stone in his bladder. Medication was giving him temporary relief. Frequent unbearable pain often used to compel him not to go out of home for earning. Being the sole bread-earner in the family, the economic hardship used to make the family members to live on one time's meal that too with difficulty.

When Hukum Singh came to know about the Free Urology Camp being organized by Jeev Sewa Sansthan at Sewa Sadan Eye Hospital, he immediately rushed and registered his name. During sonography, 70mm stone equal to mid-size potato was found in his bladder which could be extracted only by bladder surgery. The stone was removed successfully in the camp thus wiping off the worries & woes of Hukum Singh forever. The hearts of Hukum Singh & his family members were full of gratitude for the organizers of this urology camp i.e. Jai Shivshakti Health and Educational Foundation, Bengaluru and the doctors who relieved him from the agony of pain forever.

SURGERY OF A CINEMA & DRAMA ARTIST -DEVENDRA ARYA



One of the cinema artists, Mr. Devendra Arya(Age:22 years) from Ashta, a Tehsil about 100 kms away from Bhopal, is playing role of a friend of Lord Krishna in a Hindi TV serial, "Radha Krishna". He has also been playing small roles in short documentaries & dramas. Of late, he had been feeling unbearable pain. Diagnosis revealed multiple stones in his gall bladder. He visited many Super-Specialty Private Hospitals in Mumbai, Ujjain & Bhopal. He hailed from a poor family. At the stage of struggle in TV Serial Industry, he used to send money to his family after meeting out high cost of living of Mumbai. Medical treatment and operation at Mumbai was costly too. Finally, his maternal uncle advised him to register his name in the

free urology camp being organized by Jeev Sewa Sansthan at Sewa Sadan Eye Hospital sponsored by **Jai Shivshakti Health & Educational Foundation, Bengaluru.** Ultimately, his surgery was performed successfully in the camp and he is now leading a normal life. He expressed heart-felt gratitude to the sponsors of the camp and for the selfless service rendered by the doctors, volunteers & staff of Sewa Sadan Eye Hospital in the camp. He was amazed to observe the quality of post-operative care.

KIDNEY TRANSPLANTATION SURGERY







With the blessings of Paramhans Sant Hirdaram Sahib and inspirational guidance of Rev. Siddh Bhauji, Jeev Sewa Sansthan(JSS) is 'a hope beyond hope' to those who suffer from dreaded diseases like Cancer, heart malfunctioning, Thalessaemia, kidney failures etc. JSS has

provided financial help to hundreds of poor and economically weak patients to avail treatment and undergo surgeries to save their lives which were otherwise beyond their affordability. JSS is in touch with renowned hospitals of the country for arranging treatment of the poor patients on concessional rates. Besides, financial assistance is provided through our esteemed philanthropists located across the world.

Ms. Laveena Jaswani, student of Std. 9th was suffering from Chronic Kidney Disease at such a young age of 16 years. As a result, both her kidneys have been damaged and she was undergoing dialysis twice a week. The permanent solution, as suggested by the doctors, was kidney transplantation. Her father was the probable donor for the kidney. The only worrisome factor was arranging funds for the transplantation involving huge amount.

Ms. Laveena lives with her parents & her elder sister is student of Std. 10th. Her father is a sole bread winner in the family getting Rs. 10,000/- p.m. With such a meagre salary, it was not possible for him to arrange such a huge amount for kidney transplantation surgery of her daughter.

In such difficult situation, Mr. Bhagwan Jaswani (father of the patient) knocked the door of Jeev Sewa Sansthan seeking financial assistance. Realising the pitiable & critical condition of Ms. Laveena, Jeev Sewa Sansthan immediately appealed to various philanthropists located across the world.




