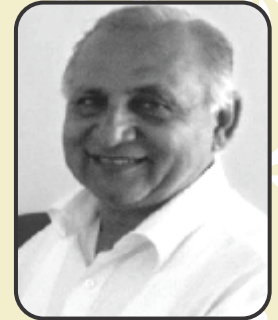

## “MY VISIT TO SANT NAGARI (BHOPAL)”



New York, America may seem a long way off from Bhopal, India but many of us have our hearts in both these two places.

I live in New York and for 25 years, I have volunteered for Children's Hope India (CHI). When this organization partnered with 'Jeev Sewa Sansthan' (JSS) to create a new girls' school, I was unable to come for the Inauguration. So now I was journeying to Bhopal to get to see this school dedicated to the education of the girl child, and a big bonus was that I was finally going to get to see the wonderful work of JSS first-hand.

There is a remarkable stretch of land in the city of Bhopal where there is a campus city of 7 schools and 5 colleges, all created by donations from Philanthropists of Indian diasporas, from Hong Kong, Singapore, USA and Dubai. The story has its direct roots in the Partition when Hindu Sindhi families lost their homeland of Sindh in 1947 and many came as

refugees without recourse to livelihood or education.

**Paramhans Sant Hirdaram Sahibji**, a spiritual head to the Sindhi community, was a great believer in helping the needy, old & infirm and in the power of education for strengthening new generation, especially women. Realizing the needs of Sindhi community which was struggling in refugee camps and in barracks formerly known as 'Barrackpore' in Bhopal, Paramhans Santji started an organization, '**Jeev Sewa Sansthan (JSS)**'.

Bit by bit, the Sindhi community was rehabilitated and given spiritual sustenance by Sant Hirdaram Sahibji. An unheralded army of supporters i.e., affluent sindhi entrepreneurs located across the world like Lakhani, Chanrai, Melwani, Ganwani and Hathiramani who themselves were the products of Partition turned to help the struggling refugees through the aegis of Paramhans Sant Hirdaram Sahibji who founded schools, colleges and hospitals through funding from Hong Kong, Dubai, London and America. They were now ready to fulfill their social responsibility by sharing their riches with needy brethren.

Due to the enterprising efforts of small community, the town called 'Bairagarh' now came to be known as 'Sant Hirdaram Nagar'. Even the railway station was given the same name after the spiritual leader who was the catalyst for this shell-shocked community. Today, successor of Santji, Shri Hotchand Dhanwani named '**Siddh Bhau**' by his guru, is a key motivator & guide to the community. **He overview, monitor and work as guide** to this massive network of hospitals, schools and colleges. He serves as a 'Chairman and Trustee' of JSS, along with the philanthropists – Shri K.H. Lakhani from Hong Kong, Shri Hero Gyanchandani, Shri Lokchand Janiyani and Shri Mahesh Dayaramani, all from Bhopal. Shri Mahesh Dayaramani, guided by Rev. Siddh Bhauji, works with the donors and the community to ensure that these plans become reality.

**Sewa Sadan Eye Hospital:** It was amazing to see how valuable an institution it is to the larger community providing all kinds of eye care to the needy ailing masses. Other health institutions included Ishwaribai Buxani Post Operative Care Center, Dada Atmaram Badlani Urology Center and Indira Hotchand Lalwani Charitable Hospital.

The schools range from 'Vidyasagar Public School' set-up in 1997 to well-acclaimed boys school, 'Mithi Gobindram Public School (1999)'. Besides, Kewalram Chanrai School set-up in 2001 followed by well-acclaimed girls school, 'Navnidh Hassomal Lakhani Public School' in 2002 and Radhibai Hassomal Khiantani School in 2005.

A great believer in girls' rights, JSS started 'Sant Hirdaram Girls College' in 2006 and Sant Hirdram Medical College of Naturopathy and Yogic Sciences in 2009.

Besides schools, colleges and hospitals, the donors from abroad contribute for various benevolent activities like providing help to widows, ration to poor families, help for major surgeries and help for performing last rites of less-privileged masses.

Nav Yuvak Parishad, one of sister organizations of JSS provide help to needy & deserving students pursuing higher education in Engineering, Medical, Fashion Designing, Chartered Accounting and Business Administration through donations from well-wishers located across the world. As a result, the students are able to widen their opportunities and move on to solid professions.

I am a co-founder and board member of New York based charitable organization, Children's Hope India (CHI) which is a group of Indian-American women professionals. Our fundraising efforts in New York reaching out to major Indians in finance, business and fashion resulted in setting-up of 'Children's Hope India Girls School' in the suburb of Gandhinagar, Bhopal. This school caters solely to the girls from surrounding villages and a quality education may not have been within the reach of these families, and many of them may had to give up education for care-giving of younger siblings or even an early marriage. The goal was to provide these rural students the best education and a level playing field to face the job market and the future. Gleaming yellow school buses, for which the funds were raised in the CHI fundraiser in New York, carry the village girls from their rural homes to adventure in education daily.

Visiting Children's Hope India Girls School in Gandhinagar was an eye-opener for me. This gleaming, brand new building was constructed within 10 months under supervision of Shri Nari Pohani, a seasoned developer from New York, USA. At the doorway of the school is a temple of Goddess of Learning, Maa Saraswati and what could be more auspicious than that? It has state-of-the-art facilities and education in English medium with a quality faculty. There are 16 large classrooms, a library and a CCTV system for the campus. Many plus points of the school include smart classrooms with digital interactive boards for teaching and learning, a well-equipped computer lab, physics, chemistry and biology labs, as well as a recreation room for sports and extra-curricular activities. Other facilities include a seminar hall for internal growth and a playground for physical activities.

Whether it is the health and well-being of all its residents including the old and the infirm or the education and vocational training of young people and future generations, Jeev Sewa Sansthan and Sant Hirdaram Nagar has been a blessing to the people of Bhopal.

### SUCCESSFUL BMT SURGERY OF MS. DIKSHA HOTCHANDANI (AGE:21 YEARS)



Around two & half years back, Ms. Diksha Hotchandani & her family members were in absolute shock when she was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukaemia (Blood Cancer). After treatment for one prolong year in a leading Cancer Hospital of Bhopal, the mother & her two brothers were overjoyed to know about her normalcy. Ms. Diksha was full of spirits & thanked God for her recovery. A huge amount had already been spent on her treatment by the family.

Everything was sailing in a swift stream but unfortunately after one year, Diksha had very high fever. Her health started deteriorating with every passing day. Once again, the family members were in distress and immediately rushed to Cancer Hospital in Bhopal. After going through medical reports, the doctors revealed that her cancer cells have relapsed. Considering a complicated case, the doctors referred her to "CHRISTIAN MEDICAL COLLEGE (CMC), VELLORE". The doctors advised for 8 cycles of Chemotherapy & Bone Marrow Transplantation (BMT) Surgery. For searching the blood-cells donor, all the family members underwent HLA Matching. Fortunately, the blood cells of younger brother of Diksha -Mr. Hitesh were perfectly matched. But now the only concern was to arrange for the heavy cost of treatment i.e., Rs. 45.00 Lacs which included Chemotherapy, HLA Matching, Pathological tests, Medicines, BMT Surgery & Post-operative Care etc.

Diksha Hotchandani is fatherless and lives with her mother & two brothers. Her mother is employed in a private organisation and both the brothers are employed as salesman getting meagre salary. Worried about the unfortunate condition of Diksha, her mother always prayed to the Almighty to send someone for her rescue & save the beloved child from trap of this dreadful disease. One of her relatives guided them to approach 'Jeev Sewa Sansthan (JSS)'.

We salute to the major role of Resp. Dada K H Lakhani (Trustee, JSS) & Mr. Mahesh Dayaramani (Secretary, JSS) who realising the weak financial condition of the family members appealed to kind-hearted philanthropists across the world to extend their helping hand in this humanitarian cause.

Besides, Resp. Dada K H Lakhani also approached 'Have A Heart Foundation' (Bengaluru) for amplifying the fund raising campaign through crowd funding for this unfortunate girl who was fighting between life & death.

The prayers of family members of Diksha & efforts of JSS were heard by the Almighty who made the philanthropists as His instruments. As a result, the BMT surgery of Diksha was successfully performed on 22<sup>nd</sup> April'2019.

When asked about her "courageous fight", she boldly said, "I always remain positive & prayed to the Almighty & Paramhans Sant Hirdaram Sahibji for my normalcy." She always displayed maturity much greater than her age.

A discourse of Rev. Dada J. P. Vaswani titled, 'How to make impossible, I'm possible' was played explaining how one must be free from the concept of 'impossible'. Rev. Dada always said, "There is nothing a man cannot do. Swami Vivekananda would say, with God, you can sail through the seas, but without God, you cannot cross the threshold. Sink deeper & deeper within you and nothing will be impossible."

Many melodious & spiritual bhajans rendering the divine aura were sung. Besides, artificial limbs sewa continued in which beneficiaries along with prosthesis were given cash & general items. The needy & less-privileged persons were also provided with monthly ration.

Rev. Dada J. P. Vaswani's relentless efforts have taken forward the vision and teachings of his Master, Sadhu T. L. Vaswani; in the form of service, education, health-care, spirituality amongst many other initiatives. **He will always be remembered as the perfect example of a perfect disciple who lead a life of selflessness, giving and of true altruism.**

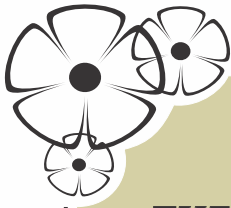

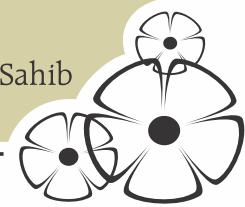
