

More than 250 students of SHIM attended

National Workshop on Bioinformatics& Data Analysis Organised in SHGC (Deptt. of Biotechnology)

A 5-days National Workshop on "Bioinformatics and Data Analysis" was organised by Sant Hirdaram Girls College (Deptt. of Bio-technology) in association with Deptt of Biological Sciences, MANIT, Bhopal from 24th to 28th September' 2019. It was attended by 75 delegates including local and outstation participants from Hoshangabad, Itarsi, Jabalpur, Goa & Maharashtra.

The course aimed to provide an introduction to the field of bioinformatics, with focus on important bioinformatics tools and resources. The course module contained combination of theoretical and practical hands on sessions so as to gain practical experience in using various tools and resources.

Eminent subject experts from different renowned national institutes i.e., Maulana Azad National Institute of Technology (MANIT), Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER), Barkatullah University, Central Institute of Agricultural Engineering (CIAE), Institute for Excellence in Higher Education (IEHE) and All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) discussed some of the vital issues raised due to current flood of biological data. Topics explored included the basics of bioinformatics and importance of databases, software used to analyse database of different organisms, data mining, and the need for more computer scientists with expertise in bioinformatics.

Students from different colleges and institutes participated and gained in-depth knowledge from this workshop. This workshop was beneficial for all those students who are pursuing B.Sc., M.Sc. and research in life sciences. The enthusiasm to learn bioinformatics software & its applications in students was observed and appreciated.

On the inaugural day, Rev. Siddh Bhauji, President, SHKES shared his views about the recent necessities of good education system and requirement of research encouragement among students by conducting such workshops and training programs. He said it is a very good initiative taken by the college and department for the welfare of students.

Valedictory programme was held on 28th September' 2019. The chief guest was Dr. Rakesh K. Arya, Director General, MPCST, Bhopal who congratulated the team and college for organizing such workshop and assured that in future MPCST will definitely provide financial assistance for the same.

Overall, the participants found the workshop well-structured, comprehensive and rich in content. The workshop provided an excellent opportunity to learn basic Bio-informatics techniques. The participants evaluated the workshop highly in terms of content and methodology. The arrangements of the workshop and commitment of the SHGC staff was highly appreciated by all participants.

Emotional Intelligence enhances your ability to lead and manage own self and others more effectively to live a healthy, progressive and joyful life. On 27th September'2019, Dr. S. Neelkanthan said, "Goal setting is the first step to achieve quantum leap in life. Goals are a necessary tool of life planning. Setting a goal requires you to think about yourself, and helps you realize what you truly want in life. You have the power to control your own life, and you are free to give whatever meaning to it, whatever you desire." He further said, "Nowadays, depression is used widely whereas in psychology there is no specific term as depression. Infact, one who is full of self-confident having strong character will face all adversities in life with encouragement & enthusiasm without any stress.

On 28th Septemebr'2019, Dr. S. Neelkanthan addressed the parents saying, "You are the role-model of your children. Children grow up watching their parents. It is your sole responsibility to demonstrate them how to live a fulfilling & happy life. Spend quality time with your children. Allow your children to feel comfortable to come and speak with you. Your child needs to hear that he/she is top priority in your life. One of the greatest gifts you can give your child is the ability to analyze and solve problems. Trust your child to decide for himself what he wants. As parents, always teach your children to be empathetic and compassionate towards others. Take them to a homeless shelter, orphanages, Ashrams etc. Allow them to witness how fortunate they are to have what they have at home. Teach your child to be a good listener, to interact without the use of technology, to be empathetic to others, and not judge anyone based on their caste, creed, religion or nationality. Exposing your child to different cultures helps develop a loving, kind, and happy person. "

- 2. What are we doing for acheiving "Real Goal" of life i.e. to be 'ONE' with our 'God'?



The noteworthy contribution of "Mahtani Family" for setting up of above centres in Sant Nagari (Bhopal) will always be remembered by the generations to come.




