After 25 days treatment, the doctors advised them to consult Pediatric Retina Specialist immediately.

As their father work as a Brickmason & mother as a daily wage worker, they did not have enough money to bring their kids to Bhopal so got delayed. After one month, these infants were brought to Sewa Sadan Eye Hospital where Dr. Deshpandey diagnosed and decided to perform retina laser procedure on both of them immediately. The Retina Laser surgery of Preterm twins has been performed successfully.

It is alarming to note that Retinopathy of Prematurity (ROP) is emerging as a significant cause of severe visual disability in Preterm born infants. Realizing their plight, Resp. This can happen only when we have full faith in God; we worship Him and meditate on Him. There are various ways to worship Him and meditate upon Him... No body


knows what the best way of worship or meditation is for no one has ever returned after visiting God's Abode.
