We were shaken to see the grim cry of ailing patients for insufficient oxygen and ICU beds across the city.

PROVIDING RATION TO 500 FAMILIES

The Govt. & Private hospitals had almost run out of oxygen supply. The patients urgently required oxygen as

their saturation levels dropped significantly. Even the recovered patients required oxygen post discharge. Due to lack of Oxygen, these Covid-19 victims met with untimely death.

Realising the distressful condition of patients, we requested our kind-hearted philanthropists to sponsor Oxygen Concentrators. At this hour of emergency, they readily contributed for buying as many as 57 oxygen concentrators. These concentrators are being provided to the home isolated patients and hospitals, wherever required.

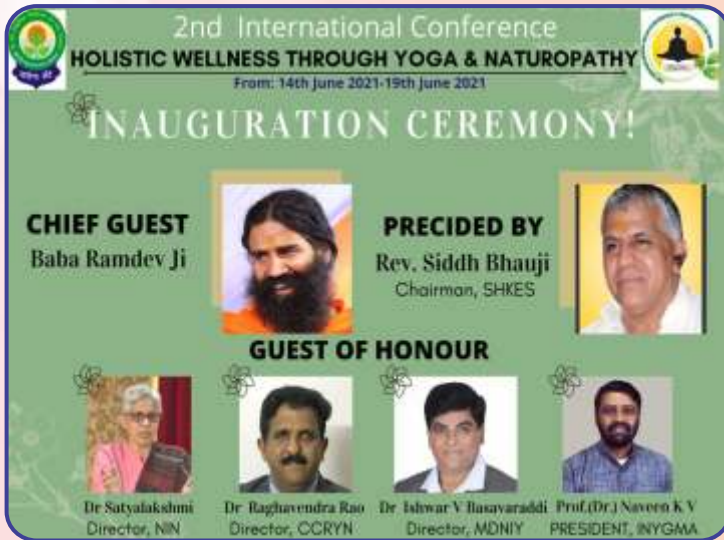

H H Gurdevji had mercy on me and he ushered blessing on me. 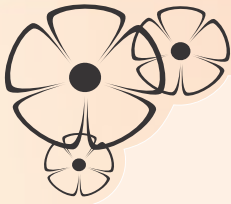


DADA DURGADAS BHARWANI, MUMBAI

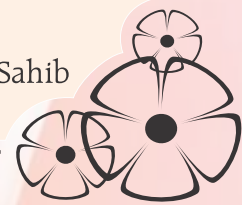
